

# Application Form - Call for Proposals Seed Grants 2025

## Datafied Warfare and Societal Resilience

The proposal must be written in English.

The proposal should not be more than 1.000 words, excluding title, applicants and budget sheet.

The proposal needs to address the following points:

### **2. Purpose of the Seed Grant**

What do you want to achieve with this Seed Grant project? What should this project lead to in the longer run? Please specify:

- Scientific case / impact: Describe the scientific innovation of the project. What makes this project unique?
- Interfaculty collaboration: Explain how this project builds on collaboration between two or more UvA faculties.
- Relevance: How does this project align with the campaign topic *Datafied Warfare and Societal Resilience* and the RDT theme as a whole?
- Societal case / impact: What is the intended social impact of the project? While non-academic partners are not required, which external partners might be interested in this research?
- Expected output and success indicators: What are the expected deliverables of the project? By what indicators will the success of this project be measured?

### **3. Practical matters & potential for follow-up**

- Staff, organization and institutional context: Describe how the project is organized. Specify how the project partners contribute to this project and for how much time?
- Briefly explain how you envision team collaboration and team activities.
- Budget (according to budgeting sheet format): Specify the amount of funding applied for (€15k-€50k)? What will the budget be spent on (e.g., staff, organization, support, etc.)? Use the budget sheet format available on the [RDT webpage](#).
- Potential Follow-up and Funding: Describe how this project could lead to potential follow-up funding? Explain why there is a reasonable possibility of acquiring additional external resources after the Seed Grant period.
